Saturday 23 October 2010**

Class 1: Preliminary 14 warm up class (for competitors in class 2 only).

Class 2: Preliminary 19 SCOTTISH & NORTHERN EQUESTRIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS.

Open to qualified affiliated Preliminary horse/pony rider combinations only. Competitors must be either a group 7 or 8 rider and horse/pony to have less than 49 points to enter this class.

Class 3: Novice 28 warm up class (for competitors in class 4a and 4b only).

Class 4: Novice 35 SCOTTISH & NORTHERN EQUESTRIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS.

- a) Open to qualified affiliated Novice Open horse/pony rider combinations only.
- b) Open to qualified affiliated Novice Restricted horse/pony rider combinations only

Class 5: Elementary 49 warm up class (for competitors in class 6a and 6b and only).

Class 6: Elementary 57 SCOTTISH & NORTHERN EQUESTRIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS.

- (a) Open to qualified affiliated Elementary Open horse/pony rider combinations only
- (b) Open to qualified affiliated Elementary Restricted horse/pony rider combinations only

Class 7: Medium 63 warm up class for competitors in Class 8a and 8b only.

Class 8: Medium 73 SCOTTISH & NORTHERN EQUESTRIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS.

- (a) Open to qualified affiliated Medium Open horse/rider combination only.
- (b) Open to qualified affiliated Medium Restricted horse/rider combination only.

Class 9: Advanced Medium 84 warm up class for competitors in Class 10a, 10b & 11.

Class 10: Advanced Medium 98 SCOTTISH & NORTHERN EQUESTRIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS

- (a) Open to qualified affiliated Advanced Medium Open horse/rider combination only.
- (b) Open to qualified affiliated Advanced Medium Restricted horse/rider combination only.
